Please note the following important information before signing below:

- This form will act as a consent form for the duration your child is a pupil at West Buckland School.
- The trips and activities covered by this consent include;
 - off-site sporting fixtures at any time
 - all offsite calendared school activities, (not including adventurous activities, residential trips and those which incur an extra charge)
- Special consent forms are necessary if a term time or holiday event incurs an extra cost to the parent or if it occurs over-night. Adventurous activities organised by the Outdoor Education department will also require a separate consent form. A consent slip will be added to a letter that is emailed or sent to parents and this must be returned to school. Consent for Boarders' activities is arranged separately. Please note that a faxed parental signature is acceptable, but an email or telephone message is not acceptable in law.
- Details of the school's sports fixtures are publicised in the school calendar, though changes and additions to sporting fixtures frequently occur during a term. Parents can tell the school that they do not want their child to take part in any particular special school trip or activity.
