The school organises transport at the start and end of every term and half term break to London Heathrow Airport, Terminal 5.

No charge is made for this service. The day before the beginning of term/half term, students are collected at Terminal 5. Pick up is between 11:00 and 14:00 and a member of staff will be present in Terminal 5 between these times. The day after the end of term/half term, drop off is at Terminal 5 at 12:00. The service is for students only and unfortunately, we are not able to transport parents, family members or other accompanying visitors.

You must book in advance if you wish to use school transport. Please email all flight details to Mr James Conlon on joc@westbuckland.com who will be pleased to book this transport for you.

Students travelling outside of these pickup/drop off times, or travelling with family members and visitors, should make their own transport arrangements to school. Taxi from Heathrow to school is approximately £210 per journey for up to four persons. Please call the school for details of local taxi companies if you wish to book taxi transport yourselves.

Bristol and Exeter Airports

Bristol Airport is one and a half hours from school. Taxi transport can be arranged for up to four persons travelling at a cost of approximately £100 per journey.

Exeter Airport is approximately one hour away. Taxi transport can be arranged for up to four persons travelling at a cost of approximately £65 per journey.

Exeter St David's Train Station

No charge is made for this service. Minibus travel to/from Exeter St David's is organised, if there is demand.
